Entries	Up to 5 adults and any number of Juniors may compete in any Car, if this is indicated on the Entry Form. Entries (on the official printed or electronic on-line entry form and accompanied by payment or proof of payment) will be accepted in order of receipt. Compulsory Drivers' Briefing	9:45am at the Event check in table.												
Document Verification	Documentation will open at 8:15am and conclude at 9:15am. Presentation of current CAMS licence and current CAMS Car Club Membership will be required for verification. Documentation must be completed for all Crew before the Vehicle is presented for Scrutiny.												
Vehicle Requirements / Vehicle Scrutiny	Scrutiny will open at 8:30am and conclude at 9:30am. Drivers of vehicles with a CAMS Log Book must present that Log Book to the Scrutineer. Vehicles will be checked for safety prior to competition and for compliance with General Requirements for Cars and Drivers Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Winter Tread, Bar-Tread, Mud/Snow pattern and Hand-cut pattern tyres are prohibited. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. A Fire Extinguisher complying with AS1841 must be securely mounted with HT bolts within reach of the Driver.												
Apparel	All apparel, including Helmet, must comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Drivers of open Vehicles and specials are required to comply with Level D outerwear (i.e., clothing from ankles to neck to wrists). Clothing of flammable synthetic material, such as nylon, is not acceptable.												
Classes	As per current Group5 Series Rules these are based on overall length (NOT wheelbase)—see next page.												
Event Conditions	Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, plus any penalties.												
Event Schedule	Competition will commence at approximately 10am following drivers briefing. A 30-minute (approx.) lunch break will start after completion of the last test to commence before 12noon. No new test will be started after 4pm.												
Other Regulatory Conditions (Awards, restrictions etc)	<p>Awards will be provided in accordance with the current Group5 Series Rules.</p> <p>Drivers 12 and 13 years of age must be accompanied by an experienced Instructor, approved by the Clerk of the Course. This event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy. Passengers are only allowed where their role is as an 'Instructor'.</p> <p>(a) A Briefing must be attended by each Driver and Instructor conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.</p> <p>(b) Instructors must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Be experienced and have the permission of the Clerk of Course. The suitability of the Instructor is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. ii. Wear the same protective gear as a Driver in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. iii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes. iv. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and disclaimer. v. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as an /Instructor. <p>(c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.</p> <p>(d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.</p> <p>(e) Any Instructor must be over 18 and hold a CAMS and civil driver's licence—details must be on the entry form.</p> <p>Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available also www.cams.com.au</p> <p>Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs or alcohol (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and/or the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing as published on the CAMS website.</p> <p>Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day.</p>

TIMING

Timing will be electronic backed up by hand held stop watch.

CLASSES

As per 2018 Group5 Series Regulations. *(Based on vehicle overall length)*

Class A: Up to 4250mm—Engine Over Driven Wheels

Class B: Up to 4250mm—Engine Away from Driven Wheel

Class C: 4251mm and over—Engine Over Driven Wheels

Class D: 4251mm and over—Engine Away from Driven Wheels

Class E: All Wheel Drive Production Vehicles

Class F: Specials / and Non-production cars*.

Class J: Juniors under the age of 18 as of the first round of the year.

Class L: Ladies

Juniors and Ladies will be scored using handicap factors for each vehicle class. Handicap factors are as follows:

Class A: 0.94; Class B: 0.90; Class C: 0.92; Class D: 0.86; Class E: 0.94; Class F: 1.00
